

Suggested Pattern for November and December (5/10/20)

This plan is based on the current guidelines for worship, in that we can use Church as long as we are careful about distancing and the other precautions and we don't sing. These rules may change (either way) but it is proving difficult to pre-guess. I think we know how to manage using the worship space now and people are getting used to the restrictions.

1st November (All Saints Day) (HJ away)

10am Morning Worship in Church (Adrian)
4pm Evening Worship in Church (Jacquie)

8th November (3 before Advent and Remembrance)

10am Morning Worship online

15th November

10am All Age Worship online (St Mark)
4pm Evening Worship in Church (St Mark) (possibly with baptisms?)

22nd November (Christ the King)

10am Morning Worship online

29th November (Advent Sunday – the Patriarchs)

10am Holy Communion* (in Church)) I would prefer to have a way
4pm Holy Communion* (in Church)) of letting people pre-book for numbers

(10am Morning Worship online if above not possible)

6th December (Advent 2 – the Prophets)

10am Morning Worship online
4pm Evening Worship in Church

13th December (Advent 3 – John the Baptist)

10am Morning Worship online

20th December (Advent 4 – Mary)

10am All Age Worship online (St John and "Nativity")
4pm Carol Service in Church

24th December (Christmas Eve)

11:15pm Holy Communion*

25th December (Christmas Day)

10am Family Communion*

27th December (*HJ away*)

10am Morning Worship (from Church preferred but could be pre-recorded)

* We will monitor the guidance from the national Church about how we might offer Communion. Currently this is bread only for the congregation, but this may change in the weeks ahead. We don't have a huge array of technology that would allow us to stream these services for those staying at home but we may be able to offer something via Facebook.
